During Spring, Year 6 will be working hard and learning successfully by:

## S U C C E S S

**History:** During Spring Term 2, we will use different sources to examine the causes of WW2 and its impact and legacy on this country, Bournemouth and other places around the world.

**RE:** We will explore particular features of the Sikh religion including the commitment a Sikh demonstrates and the skills this can teach us and the relevance of Sikh stories today.

**Science:** We will study the human body, in particular, looking at the digestive and circulatory system, the role of the heart and other major organs and the impact of diet and exercise on our body.

**D&T:** We will study the DT cycle of investigating current ideas and analysing, planning our own work, creating, before evaluating a final product, and then apply this model to our own learning.

**Project Overviews:**  
During Spring Term 1, we will complete a whole school project based on Paddington, applying geography, DT and art skills. During Spring Term 2, we will focus on WW2 and the reasons for and the impact of this war.

**English:** We will continue to write for a range of audiences and purposes, drafting and editing our writing to apply the full range of grammatical skills. Children will continue to practise spelling patterns regularly. In reading, we will focus on the range of question types including retrieving, inferring and understanding authors choice of language.

**Year Group Information:**  
PE will take place on Thursdays and Fridays.  
Spelling Tests will continue on a Thursday.  
Timestables tests will be on a Friday.

**Maths:** We will further develop understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages including using the four operations with fractions. In geometry we will look at properties of shape and position and direction. Children will apply their learning through solving reasoning and problem solving questions.

**Geography:** We will explore the diverse landscape of a non-European country (Chile) examining the human and physical features which shape the region.

**Worship:** Though whole school, key stage and class worship, we will explore themes of gentleness and patience and during Spring Term 2, we will focus on lent.

**Art:** We will look at the range of ways to combine colours to enhance the mood of a piece of art, using a range of brush and sketching techniques, continuing to develop a personal style by learning from artists.

**PE:** We will continue to explore fitness, as well as the range of skills needed in striking and fielding games.

**Learning Opportunities to Apply Learning:**  
To give the children opportunity to apply their learning, we have an application day where the children will independently develop a number of taught skills.
