Things to practice at home  
Practicing phonics cards (4 a week). Cutting – using pairs of scissors, practice writing their names.

Maths  
Knowing our numbers to 10 and listening to songs and number rhymes.  
1:1 counting  
Addition and subtraction – one more and less.

Fine motor development  
Funky finger activities and Physical development activities including muscle strengthening.

Worship  
Listening to and learning worship song's actions. Also learning a lunchtime prayer. Knowing why we light a candle in worship time.

Art  
Mixing colours and using them in different ways.  
Making autumn pictures using our fingers and leaves.  
Painting pictures of ourselves and Paddington.

PE  
Experimenting with different ways of moving. Changing direction and different balances.
