History

RE

French

This term we will be learning how to introduce ourselves, comment about the type of games we like and know the words for colours, numbers and basic parts of our body.

The Ancient Egyptians -non-fiction



English

This term we will be writing character and setting descriptions and basing our non-fiction writing on the Egyptians. In grammar, we will revise nouns, adjectives and verbs and learn when to use the determiners 'a' or 'an'. We will be spelling with suffixes, skimming and scanning and retrieving information from texts.

Maths

This term we will be working on understanding Place Value, the value of each digit in a three-digit number and using and drawing representations of number in various different ways. We will be learning how to add a single digit number to a three digit number using the column method and about exchanging when we have more than ten 'Ones'.
